(Fr Neil will **not** be available for Confessions today!)

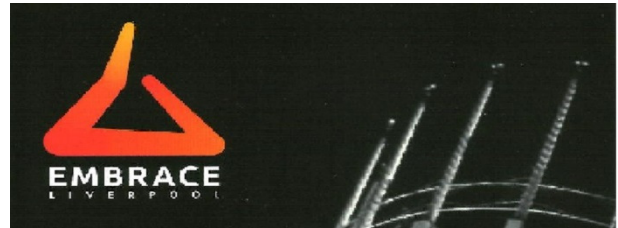
*In the Chaplaincy Centre – entrance via the Blackburne Place gates.
