Tuesday: No Morning prayer, breakfast or Mass

Thursday is the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. It is a Holy Day of obligation (that means you have to go to Mass!!).

no Adoration, but there **will** be £1 supper at 6.15pm – and perhaps a film afterwards!
